

General Instructions and Information

Spay/Neuter Transport Program

- Transport days are the second Tuesday and Wednesday of every month. Drop off time is approximately 6:30 pm and pickup time is approximately 7:30 pm. Please arrive at the drop off/pickup site (Tractor Supply on Main Street in Viroqua) at least 15 minutes prior to the van's anticipated arrival.
- To ensure a reservation, we **MUST** receive a signed Surgical Release form and payment no later than 5 pm the Thursday before the transport date. **If payment is NOT received by this date, a reservation will not be made**, even if a surgical release form has been received. If a reservation is made and you, or one of your scheduled pets, is a **NO SHOW**, you will be charged a **\$25 no show fee**. At this time, we **ONLY** accept checks or cash. **Please send** (snail mail or e-mail) the consent form with services requested and payment to: Alter-Ations Inc., E9624 County Rd SS, Viroqua, WI 54665.
- Your pet(s) can be fed no later than 4 pm the day of the transport.
- Spay Me Clinic is **REQUIRED BY STATE LAW** to have one of their veterinarians speak to each owner to go over the procedure, aftercare, etc. Surgery **CANNOT** be performed on your pet if a veterinarian has not spoken with you. Please list 2 phone numbers, if possible, to best ensure that a veterinarian can contact you in a timely manner.

CAT SPECIFIC:

- √ Cats **MUST** be in secure crates provided by the pet owner. NO soft-sided carriers! Alter-Ations has a limited number of carriers available to loan.
- √ Carriers should be lined with newspaper. No towels, blankets, etc. **DO NOT** put litterboxes in carrier!
- √ Your cat(s) will be transferred to a kennel on arrival at Spay Me Clinic. If sending more than 1 cat and you would like them kenneled together, please let us know so that the information can be made known to the Clinic staff.

DOG SPECIFIC:

- √ Please have your dog on a leash and wearing an appropriately fitted collar.
- √ **DO NOT** send your dog with leash, blankets, toys, etc.
- √ Your dog(s) will be housed overnight in a kennel at the Spay Me Clinic.
